Insurance Services:

CSC VLEs, registered as Rural Authorized Persons (RAPs), can offer multiple insurance products with the following commission **CSC rate chart**:

Motor Comprehensive	15% - 17.5% of Own Damage (OD)
Motor Third Party	2.5%
Health Insurance	15%
Fire Insurance	16.5%
Marine Cargo	16.5%
Personal Accident	16.5%
Farmer Package	16.5%
Hospital Cash	16.5%
Travel Insurance	16.5%

Banking Services:

VLEs acting as Business Correspondents (BCs) for various banks earn commissions on transactions such as account openings, deposits, withdrawals, and loan disbursements. Specific rates may vary depending on the bank's policies.

Utility Payments:

Commissions for facilitating utility payments (electricity, water, gas) and recharges (mobile, DTH) typically range between **1% to 4%**, depending on the service provider.

Government to Citizen (G2C) Services:

For services like PAN card applications, passport services, and various state-specific services, VLEs receive a fixed fee per transaction, which varies based on the specific service and state regulations.

Educational Services:

Commissions for services such as online form fillings, exam registrations, and training program enrollments vary depending on the educational institution or governing body.
